


GRADE 5-6 QUESTIONS AND SOLUTIONS

Q1: Read the speech bubble and answer the question (1 point)

ANSWER IS B

- D) Erica had visited Tokyo City View Observation Deck, Tokyo National Museum, Ueno Park but Tokyo Skytree.

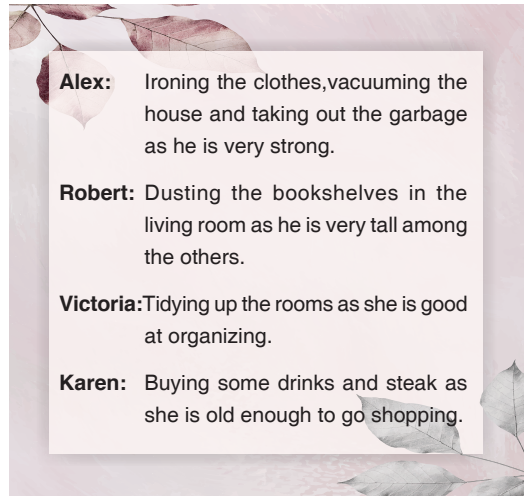
ANSWER IS C

Which of the following is wrong related to the information above?

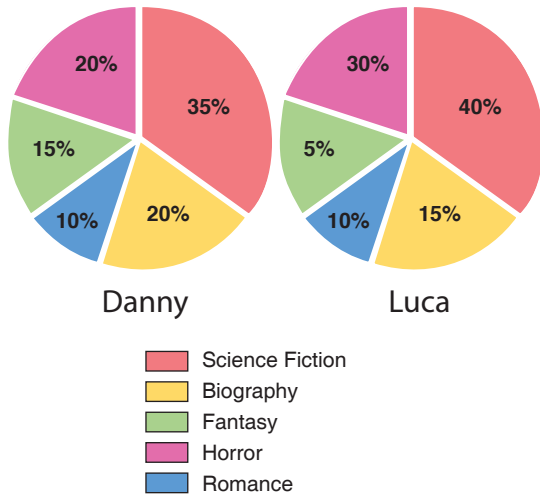
- A) Purchasing beverages and meat products is Karen's responsibility.

- D) Alex

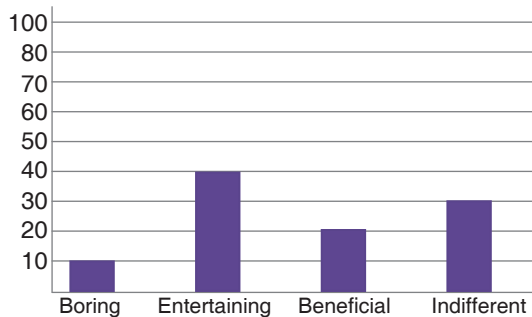
ANSWER IS B
